

Study Guide for Inquiry Module 6: Dominican Study

The purpose of the Inquiry phase of formation is to provide individuals an opportunity to begin discerning a vocation to the lay Dominican life. Essential to this process is a fundamental understanding of assiduous study and how Dominicans make this a part of daily life.

PRAYER/CONTEMPLATION
